



LOCAL 705 I.B.T. PENSION PLAN PROOF OF AGE LIST

In order to be eligible for retirement benefits, you must furnish proof of your age. If you are married, you must also furnish proof of your spouse's age and Marriage Certificate.

You are required to furnish the best proof available. The following list shows the documents that serve as acceptable proof of your age in order of preference. Original or certified copies of documents are required and will be returned to you. Additional proof may be requested if the document you submit is not convincing proof.

1. Official birth certificate from the Bureau of Vital Statistics (or the state agency responsible for maintaining or issuing birth certificates). This is the preferred proof and only if it is impossible to obtain should any other document of proof be submitted. You must provide executed copies of any other document provided as proof of age;
2. Baptismal certificate or statement as to date of birth shown by a church record, certified by the custodian thereof;
3. Census Bureau notification of birth registration;
4. Hospital birth record or certificate;
5. Foreign church or government record;
6. Certification by physician or midwife in attendance at birth as to date of birth shown on the physician's or midwife's records;
7. Certificate of Bible or other family records;
8. Any **two** of the following which show date of birth:
 - a. Naturalization record;
 - b. Immigration papers;
 - c. Military records;
 - d. Passport;
 - e. School records certified by the custodian thereof;
 - f. Life insurance policy with application;
 - g. Labor union or fraternal record certified by the custodian thereof;
 - h. Marriage license or certificate if it states full birth dates.
